The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4(4), 7(4) and 10(1) of the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 10(2) of that Act⁽²⁾, a draft of this Order has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament.
