#### PART 2

##### Offices and employments

7. Any office, employment or work which is concerned with the administration of, or is otherwise normally carried out wholly or partly within the precincts of a prison, remand centre, young offenders institution, detention centre or removal centre, and members of visiting committees for prisons appointed under rules made under section 39 of the Prisons (Scotland) Act 1989<sup>(1)</sup> and members of visiting committees for remand centres and young offenders institutions appointed under section 19(3)<sup>(2)</sup> of that Act.
