Article 3

THE DESIGNATED AREA

The area of sea around the islands of Orkney below mean high water springs enclosed by a line extending from Tor Ness on the island of Hoy at $58^{\circ} 47'N 3^{\circ} 17.5'W$; then due south to a point at $58^{\circ} 45'N 3^{\circ} 17.5'W$; then due east to Barth Head on South Ronaldsay at $58^{\circ} 45'N 2^{\circ} 59'W$; then north and west along the shoreline of South Ronaldsay and the mainland to Breck Ness on the mainland at $58^{\circ} 58'N 3^{\circ} 21'W$; then south and west to the Kame of Hoy on Hoy at $58^{\circ} 55.5'N 3^{\circ} 24'W$; then east, south and west along the shoreline of Hoy to the start point at Tor Ness at $58^{\circ} 47'N 3^{\circ} 17.5'W$.
