The Smoke Control Areas (Exempted Fireplaces) (Scotland) Order 1999

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 21 of the Clean Air Act 1993(1) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, being satisfied that the classes of fireplace exempted by this Order can be used for burning fuel other than authorised fuels without producing any smoke or a substantial quantity of smoke, hereby make the following Order:
