The Argyll and Clyde Acute Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment (No. 2) Order 1999

Amendment of the principal Order

2.—(1) For article 3 of the principal Order there is substituted—

“Nature and functions of the trust

3.—(1) The trust is established for the purpose specified in section 12A(1) of the Act.

(2) The trust’s functions shall be to provide goods and services for the purpose of the Health Service at, from or through hospital accommodation and facilities at Inverclyde Royal Hospital, Greenock, Vale of Leven District General Hospital, Greenock, Vale of Leven District General Hospital, Alexandria, Lorn and Islands District General Hospital, Oban, Royal Alexandra Hospital, Paisley and at establishments associated with those hospitals, and also including the management of any teaching and research facilities associated with those establishments and the support services related thereto and a new in-patient and day hospital facility on land at Larkfield Road, Greenock.”

(2) In article 4 of the principal Order (directors of the trust) for the words “non-executive directors” there is substituted “trustees”.
