The Advice and Assistance (Financial Conditions) (Scotland) Regulations 2000

Liability to pay fees or outlays under section 11(2) of the Act

5. The maximum amount of fees or outlays which a client shall be liable to pay under section 11(2) of the Act⁽¹⁾, where his disposable income falls within a range specified in the first column of the following table, shall be the amount specified in relation to that range in the second column:—

<i>Disposable income range</i>	<i>Maximum contribution</i>
1. Exceeding £76 but not exceeding £83 a week	£7
2. Exceeding £83 but not exceeding £90 a week	£14
3. Exceeding £90 but not exceeding £97 a week	£21
4. Exceeding £97 but not exceeding £104 a week	£28
5. Exceeding £104 but not exceeding £111 a week	£35
6. Exceeding £111 but not exceeding £118 a week	£42
7. Exceeding £118 but not exceeding £125 a week	£49
8. Exceeding £125 but not exceeding £132 a week	£56
9. Exceeding £132 but not exceeding £139 a week	£63
10. Exceeding £139 but not exceeding £146 a week	£70
11. Exceeding £146 but not exceeding £153 a week	£77
12. Exceeding £153 but not exceeding £160 a week	£84
