**The Animal Feedingstuffs from Belgium  
(Control) (Scotland) Revocation Regulations 2000**

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animal Feedingstuffs from Belgium (Control) (Scotland) Revocation Regulations 2000 and shall come into force on 21st June 2000.

**Revocation**

2. The Animal Feedingstuffs from Belgium (Control) (Scotland) Regulations 2000<sup>(2)</sup> are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

These Regulations, which apply to Scotland, revoke the Animal Feedingstuffs from Belgium (Control) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 (S.S.I.2000/16), and implement in Scotland, in relation to products for animal feeding, Commission Decision [2000/301/EC](#) repealing the protective measure with regard to contamination by dioxins of certain products of porcine and poultry origin intended for human or animal consumption (O.J. No. L97, 19.04.2000, p.16).
