The West of Scotland Water Authority  
(Lochnaw) Ordinary Drought Order 2000

**Interpretation**

**2.** In this Order—

“the Act” means the Natural Heritage (Scotland) Act 1991;

“the Authority” means the West of Scotland Water Authority established under section 62 of the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994<sup>(1)</sup>;

“day” means a period of 24 hours reckoned from midnight;

“deposited plan” means the plans, prepared in duplicate, docketed and signed as relevant to this Order and marked “The West of Scotland Water Authority (Lochnaw) Ordinary Drought Order 2000, location plan” one copy of which is deposited in the office of the Scottish Executive, Victoria Quay, Edinburgh, and the other in the office of the Chief Executive of the Authority at 419 Balmore Road, Glasgow, G22 6NU;

“gauge” includes a gauge, weir or other apparatus for measuring the flow of water;

“intake” includes any work by which water is taken by the Authority for the purpose of the undertaking;

“the relevant period” means a period of six months beginning with the day on which this Order comes into force;

“undertaking” means the water undertaking for the time being of the Authority;

“works” means the works described in the Schedule to this Order and in the lines and situations and according to the levels shown on the deposited plan.
