**ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION**

**The Financial Assistance for Environmental  
Purposes (Scotland) Order 2000**

*Made - - - - 30th November 2000*  
*Laid before the Scottish*  
*Parliament - - - - 30th November 2000*  
*Coming into force - - 1st January 2001*

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 153(4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990(1) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

**Citation, commencement and extent**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Financial Assistance for Environmental Purposes (Scotland) Order 2000 and shall come into force on 1st January 2001.

(2) This Order extends to Scotland only.

**Variation of section 153(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990**

2. Section 153(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990(2) (purposes for which financial assistance may be given), shall be varied by adding after paragraph (l) the following paragraph:—

“(mm) the programme known as the Strategic Waste Fund.”.
