The NHS 24 (Scotland) Order 2001

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1)(b), (1A), (1B) and (1C) and 105(7) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978⁽¹⁾, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c. 46).
