**The Housing Revenue Account General Fund Contribution
Limits (Scotland) Order 2001**

<i>Made</i>	<i>12th February 2001</i>
<i>Laid before the Scottish Parliament</i>	<i>14th February 2001</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>15th March 2001</i>

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 204 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1987(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Revenue Account General Fund Contribution Limits (Scotland) Order 2001 and shall come into force on 15th March 2001.

General fund contribution limits

2. The amount of contribution out of their general fund which a local authority may estimate that they will carry to the credit of their housing revenue account for the year 2001-2002 shall be limited to nil.

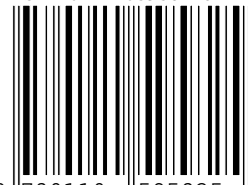
This Order provides that local authorities may not include in their estimates for the year 2001-2002 any contribution from their general fund to their housing revenue account.
