The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30(2) of the International Criminal Court (Scotland) Act 2001(a), hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the International Criminal Court (Scotland) Act 2001 (Commencement) Order 2001.
