The National Health Service (Choice of Medical Practitioner) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2001

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 17F(1), (2) and (5), 105(7) and 108(1) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(1) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:

Section 17F was inserted by section 23(2) of the National Health Service (Primary Care) Act 1997 (c. 46); section 105(7) was amended by the Health Services Act 1980 (c. 53), Schedule 6, paragraph 5 and Schedule 7 and by the Health and Social Services and Social Security Adjudication Act 1983 (c. 41), Schedule 9, paragraph 24; section 108(1) contains definitions of “prescribed” and “regulations” relevant to the exercise of the statutory powers under which these Regulations are made. The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c. 46).
