**The Regulation of Investigatory Powers  
(Source Records) (Scotland) Regulations 2002**

**Interpretation**

**2.** In these Regulations—

“the 2000 Act” means the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Scotland) Act 2000;

“relevant investigating authority” has the meaning given by section 7(7) of the 2000 Act, but the qualification in section 7(8) does not apply;

“source” means a covert human intelligence source; and

“undercover operative” means a source who holds an office, rank or position with a relevant investigating authority.
