In Rule 5(1)(a) of the Children's Hearings (Legal Representation) (Scotland) Rules 2001(**2**) for "the Social Work (Panels of Persons to Safeguard the Interests of Children) (Scotland) Regulations 2001" substitute "the Panels of Persons to Safeguard the Interests of Children (Scotland) Regulations 2001".
