**The Health Education Board for
Scotland Amendment Order 2003**

Amendment of article 4 of the principal Order

- 5.—(1) In article 4(1) of the principal Order, after sub paragraph (a) insert—
- “(aa) functions in relation to the provision of research and development services in the field of public health conferred upon the Scottish Ministers by the Act”.
- (2) In article 4(2)(d) of the principal Order omit—
- “disregarding so much of that sub-section as relates to the function of the Secretary of State to authorise certain officers to execute instruments on his behalf”.
- (3) In article 4(3) of the principal Order for sub paragraph (b) substitute—
- “(b) that, where any such instrument requires to be executed by the Scottish Ministers it is executed by a member of the Scottish Executive in accordance with paragraph 6 of Schedule 2 to the Requirements of Writing (Scotland) Act 1995⁽¹⁾
