EXEMPTIONS – CATEGORIES AND EVIDENCE

<i>Column (1) Category</i>	<i>Column (2) Evidence</i>
1. Under 18 years of age.	1. The person's birth certificate
2. Under 19 years of age and receiving a qualifying full time education (within the meaning of paragraph 7 of Schedule 11 to the Act)(1).	2. The person's birth certificate and a document signed by the principal or other appropriate officer of the recognised educational establishment, or by or on behalf of the person providing instruction by other comparable means, to the effect that the person is receiving full-time instruction at the establishment or by other comparable means.
3. Expectant mother.	3. A certificate, signed by a medical practitioner, as to the pregnancy.
4. Having borne a child in the previous 12 months.	4. The child's birth certificate.
