**The Lanarkshire Primary Care National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 2003**

*Made* - - - - 22nd May 2003

*Coming into force* - - 23rd May 2003

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 12A(1) and (4) and 105(6) of, and paragraphs 1 and 3(1)(b) of Schedule 7A to the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Lanarkshire Primary Care National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 2003 and shall come into force on 23rd May 2003.

**Amendment of the principal Order**

2. In article 3(2)(a) of the Lanarkshire Primary Care National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1998<sup>(2)</sup>, after “Hamilton,” insert “Stonehouse Hospital”.
