**The Housing Revenue Account General Fund Contribution  
Limits (Scotland) Order 2003**

<i>Made</i>	<i>30th January 2003</i>
<i>Laid before the Scottish Parliament</i>	<i>4th February 2003</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>17th March 2003</i>

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 204 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1987(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Revenue Account General Fund Contribution Limits (Scotland) Order 2003 and shall come into force on 17th March 2003.

**General fund contribution limits**

2. The amount of contribution out of their general fund which a local authority may estimate that they will carry to the credit of their housing revenue account for the year 2003-2004 shall be limited to nil.
