**The Crime (International Co-operation) Act 2003  
(Commencement No. 1) (Scotland) Order 2004**

*Made - - - - 31st March 2004*

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 94(3)(b) of the Crime (International Co-operation) Act 2003(1), hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and extent**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Crime (International Co-operation) Act 2003 (Commencement No. 1) (Scotland) Order 2004.

(2) This Order extends to Scotland only.

**Appointed day**

2. The day appointed for the coming into force of section 89 of the Crime (International Co-operation) Act 2003 is 26th April 2004.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order, which extends to Scotland only, brings into force on 26th April 2004 section 89 of the Crime (International Co operation) Act 2003. Section 89 inserts a new section 46A into the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995, which relates to offences in respect of false monetary instruments.
