The Town and Country Planning (Fees for Applications and Deemed Applications) (Scotland) Regulations 2004

Fees for certain applications for the prior approval of the planning authority

13.—(1) Where an application is made to a planning authority for determination as to whether the prior approval of the authority will be required in relation to development under Schedule 1 to the General Permitted Development Order a fee shall be paid to that authority of £46, and on or after 1st April 2005, £50.

(2) Any fee paid under this regulation shall be refunded if the application is rejected as invalidly made.
