The Ura Firth, Shetland Scallops Several Fishery Order 2004

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the applicant” means Ben Wilcock, Northmavine Shellfish, The Smithy, Hillwick, Shetland, ZE2 9RW;

“creel” means a basket, small cage, pot, receptacle or container with one or more openings or entrances which may be baited and is placed on the seabed for the purpose of catching shellfish;

“the grantee” means the applicant or such other person as is for the time being entitled to the right of several fishery conferred by this Order;

“the fishery” means that part of Ura Firth, Shetland described in the Schedule to this Order.
