**The Sweeteners in Food Amendment  
(Scotland) Regulations 2004**

**Amendments to the Sweeteners in Food Regulations 1995**

- 3.—(1) In regulation 2(1) (interpretation)—
- (a) at the end of the definition of “Directive 94/35/EC”(1), insert—  
“and by Directive 2003/115/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council(2)
  - (b) in the definition of “Directive 95/31/EC”, for “Directive 2000/51 and Directive 2001/52/EC;”(3), substitute—  
“Directive 2000/51/EC, Directive 2001/52/EC and Directive 2004/46/EC(4);”; and
  - (c) for the definition of “permitted sweetener”, substitute—  
““permitted sweetener” means any sweetener specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1 which satisfies the specific purity criteria for that sweetener specified in the Annex to Directive 95/31/EC”.
- (2) In regulation 2(3)(c)(ii), before “saccharin” in the second place where it occurs, insert “the”.
