The Additional Support for Learning (Changes in School Education) (Scotland) Regulations 2005

Changes in school education

2. The following changes in the school education of children and young persons are specified(1) changes for the purposes of section 13(6) of the Act–

- (a) where a child under school age begins to receive school education provided in a school under the management of an education authority or in pursuance of arrangements entered into by an authority under section 35 of the Standards in Scotland's Schools etc. Act 2000(2);
- (b) where a child begins to receive primary education;
- (c) where a child begins to receive secondary education ('secondary education' being construed in accordance with section 135(2)(b) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980(3);
- (d) where, other than as a consequence of one of the changes specified in paragraphs (a), (b) or (c) above, a child or young person transfers, otherwise than temporarily, from a school under the management of an education authority to another school under the management of that authority or otherwise transfers from such a school in pursuance of arrangements entered into by that authority; and
- (e) where, other than as a consequence of one of the changes specified in paragraphs (a), (b),
 (c) or (d) above, or other than in the circumstances provided for in sections 12(5) and 13(1) of the Act, an education authority cease to be responsible for the school education of a child or young person.
