

EXECUTIVE NOTE

The Common Services Agency (Membership and Procedure) Amendment (Scotland) Regulations 2005 SSI/2005/550

The above instrument was made in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 10 (2) and 105 (7) and 108 (1) of, and paragraphs 3A and 8 of Schedule 5 to, the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978 (a) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf. The instrument is subject to negative resolution procedures.

Policy Objective

Currently, The Common Services Agency (Membership and Procedure) Regulations 1991 provide for remuneration to be paid under paragraph 3A of Schedule 5 to the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978 to those members who are not also officers of the Agency, a Board or the Secretary of State.

The amendment allows remuneration to be paid to members of staff of the Agency, but not to members of staff of a Health Board (including a Special Health Board) or the Scottish Administration

Consultation

The NHS National Services Scotland Board (formerly known as the Common Services Agency) was consulted prior to the preparation of this instrument.

Financial Effects

This instrument has no financial effects on the Scottish Executive, local government or on business. As this instrument does not impact on Scottish business no Regulatory Impact Assessment has been carried out.
