Swiss plant passports

PART B

Relevant material imported into Switzerland from another third country which, if it would normally be permitted to be landed in Scotland if accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate, may be accompanied by a Swiss plant passport⁽¹⁾ or may be landed without phytosanitary documentation⁽²⁾

6. Fruit of—

- (a) *Momordica* L. or *Solanum melongena* L.; or
- (b) *Annona* L., *Cydonia* L., *Diospyros* L., *Malus* Mill., *Mangifera* L., *Passiflora* L., *Prunus* L., *Psidium* L., *Pyrus* L., *Ribes* L., *Syzygium* Gaertn. or *Vaccinium*, originating in any country outside Europe.
