The Transport of Animals (Cleansing and Disinfection) (Scotland) Regulations 2005

Powers of inspectors in case of default

- **10.**—(1) If a person fails to comply with a requirement of these Regulations or a requirement contained in a notice served under them, an inspector may take any steps that the inspector considers necessary to ensure the requirement is met.
 - (2) Any steps taken are without prejudice to proceedings for an offence arising out of the default.
- (3) The person in default shall reimburse any reasonable expenses incurred by the Scottish Ministers or a local authority in taking such steps and any such reimbursement is recoverable as a civil debt.
