

EXECUTIVE NOTE

THE M77 (MALLETSHEUGH) (SPEED LIMIT) (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2005 SSI/2005/655

The above instrument was made in exercise of the powers conferred by section 17(2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The instrument is subject to negative resolution procedure.

Policy Objectives

The purpose of the instrument is to impose a 60 mph speed limit on the above stretch of road. The Regulations are necessary because the adjoining section of the M77 is subject to a 60 mph speed restriction and for safety reasons, the same limit should apply in the vicinity of Maidenhill Junction.
