**The Erskine Bridge (Temporary
Suspension of Tolls) Order 2006**

Made - - - - 16th March 2006
Laid before the Scottish
Parliament - - - - 16th March 2006
Coming into force on 1st April 2006

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Erskine Bridge Tolls Act 1968⁽¹⁾ and of all others enabling them in that behalf, and having given not less than fourteen days' public notice in accordance with section 6(3) of that Act, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Erskine Bridge (Temporary Suspension of Tolls) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 1st April 2006.

Provision

2. The tolls leviable in accordance with the Erskine Bridge Tolls Order 1992⁽²⁾ shall be suspended during the period beginning on 1st April 2006 and ending on 1st July 2006 at 2400 hours.
