The A85 Trunk Road (Methven) (30mph and Methven Primary School Part-time  
20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2)(a), 83(1) and 84(1)(a) and (c) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A85 Trunk Road (Methven) (30mph and Methven Primary School Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2007.

**30mph speed limit**

2. Subject to article 3, no person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30mph.

### **Part-time 20mph speed limit**

3. (1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 20mph when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) A 20mph speed limit applies to the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order when a 20mph speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (a).

### **Revocation of previous Order**

4. Part 1, Paragraph 42(a) of The Tayside Region (Restricted Roads) Order 1988 is revoked and the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order is directed to cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

SCHEDULE 1

That length of the A85 Perth – Lochearnhead Trunk Road at Methven from a point 90 metres or thereby west of its junction with the Methven – Millhaugh – Buchanty Road westwards to a point 157 metres or thereby west of its junction with James Street, a distance of 1.21 kilometres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 2

That length of the A85 Perth – Lochearnhead Trunk Road at Methven from a point 27 metres or thereby east of the extended west kerbline of Culdeesland Road to a point 219 metres or thereby west of the extended west kerbline of Culdeesland Road, a distance of 246 metres or thereby.
