**The Local Government (Allowances and Expenses) (Scotland) Regulations 2007**

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 50 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973<sup>(1)</sup>, section 18 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989<sup>(2)</sup>, sections 11 and 16 of the Local Governance (Scotland) Act 2004<sup>(3)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consideration of the information, advice and recommendations given to them by the Scottish Local Authorities Remuneration Committee in accordance with the requirements of section 11(4) of the Local Governance (Scotland) Act 2004, make the following Regulations:
