**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A725/A726 Trunk Road (Whitemoss Roundabout)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2007

*Made*  
*Coming into force*

*21<sup>st</sup> February 2007*  
*7<sup>th</sup> March 2007*

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, being satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order should be prohibited from making any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order, and being satisfied that there is an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, hereby make the following Order:

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the A725/A726 Trunk Road (Whitemoss Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2007 and shall come into force on the 7<sup>th</sup> of March 2007 and shall cease to have effect at midnight on the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2007.

**Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns.**

2. Subject to Articles 3 and 4 of this Order, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order, so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order, when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs and General Directions 2002(b).

### **Permission or Direction of Police Constable**

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

### **Exemption for emergency and works vehicles**

4. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

## **SCHEDULE**

### **PART 1**

That length of the A725/A726 Shawhead – East Kilbride – Carmunnock Bypass Trunk Road being Whitemoss Roundabout, East Kilbride, a distance of 100 metres or thereby.

### **PART 2**

1. Left turns from the northbound carriageway of the A725 at Whitemoss Roundabout onto the westbound carriageway of Whitemoss Avenue, East Kilbride.
2. Right turns from the westbound carriageway of Calderwood Road onto the northbound carriageway of the A725 at Whitemoss Roundabout, East Kilbride.
3. Right turns from the northbound carriageway of the A725 at Whitemoss Roundabout onto the eastbound carriageway of Calderwood Road, East Kilbride.
