**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A82 Trunk Road (Tarbet) (30 mph Speed Limit) Variation and Arrochar Primary School (Part-time 20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (c) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Tarbet) (30 mph Speed Limit) Variation and Arrochar Primary School (Part-time 20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2007.

**Variation of the A82 and A83 Trunk Roads (Tarbet) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 1995**

**2.—(1)** The A82 and A83 Trunk Roads (Tarbet) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 1995 (c) is varied in accordance with the following paragraphs:

(2) In article 2 at the beginning insert "Subject to article 2A below,"

(3) After article 2 insert—

"2A. —(1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order at a speed exceeding 20mph when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) A 20 mph speed limit applies to the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order when a 20 mph speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (a).”

(4) After Schedule 2 to the Order insert the Schedule to this Order.

That length of the A82 Dalnottar – Inverness Trunk Road at Tarbet from a point 21 metres or thereby southwest of the centre line of Bemersyde Road northeastwards to a point 181 metres or thereby northeast of the centre line of Bemersyde Road, a distance of 202 metres or thereby.
