The Students' Allowances (Scotland) Regulations 2007

Persons eligible for allowances

- **3.**—(1) The Scottish Ministers may pay an allowance, in accordance with the provisions of section 73(f) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980 and these Regulations, to or in respect of any person undertaking a course of education who is a person described in one or more paragraphs of Schedule 1.
- (2) Schedule 2 shall have effect as regards determining whether a person is to be treated, for the purposes of Schedule 1, as being, or having been, ordinarily resident in a place at, or for, a particular time
