The Bell College of Technology (Transfer and Closure) (Scotland) Order 2007

Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them:—

“the Act” means the Further and Higher Education (Scotland) Act 1992;

“the College” means Bell College of Technology, being an institution designated under section 44 of the Act⁽¹⁾;

“governing body”:

- (a) in relation to the College, means The Board of Governors of Bell College of Technology constituted in terms of article 3 of the Bell College of Technology (Scotland) Order of Council 2001⁽²⁾ and incorporated under section 45(2) of the Act;
- (b) in relation to the University, means the Court of the University of Paisley, constituted and incorporated by the Paisley College of Technology Scheme 1954⁽³⁾ and renamed in accordance with articles 3 and 4 of the University of Paisley (Scotland) Order of Council 1993⁽⁴⁾;

“the Transfer Date” means 1st August 2007; and

“the University” means the University of Paisley, being an institution designated under section 44 of the Act⁽⁵⁾.
