**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A835/A893 Trunk Road (Achilty) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2007

*Made*

12<sup>th</sup> February 2007

*Coming into force*

2<sup>nd</sup> March 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A835/A893 Trunk Road (Achilty) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2007 .

**Restriction of speed**

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order provided that the said prohibition shall apply only to the part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(c).

## SCHEDULE

That length of the A835/A893 Tore - Ullapool Trunk Road at Achilty from a point 140 metres or thereby north of the extended centreline of Tor View northwards, then westwards, then northwards to a point 70 metres or thereby north of the extended north edge of the access road leading to the property known as 'Treetops', a distance of 875 metres or thereby.
