ROAD TRAFFIC

The A78 Trunk Road (Nelson Street, Greenock)
(Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2007

<i>Made</i>	<i>8th March 2007</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>31st March 2007</i>

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, being satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order should be prohibited from making any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road, and being satisfied that there is an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, hereby make the following Order:

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as The A78 Trunk Road (Nelson Street, Greenock) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 31st March 2007 and shall cease to have effect at midnight on 30th September 2007.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to Articles 3 and 4 of this Order, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002^(b).

Permission or Direction of Police Constable

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

4. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

That length of the A78 Greenock – Prestwick Trunk Road being the junction of Newton Street and Nelson Street, Greenock, a distance of 50 metres or thereby.

PART 2

1. Right turns from the westbound carriageway of Newton Street to the northbound carriageway of the A78 Greenock – Prestwick Trunk Road at Nelson Street, Greenock.
2. Left turns from the westbound carriageway of Newton Street to the southbound carriageway of the A78 Greenock – Prestwick Trunk Road at Nelson Street, Greenock.
