ROAD AND BRIDGES

The M8/ A8 Trunk Road (Ratho Street to Port Glasgow Road) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 62(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, being of the opinion that a temporary prohibition of waiting, loading and unloading on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is desirable because of considerations of public safety and convenience, hereby make the following Order:

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the M8/ A8 Trunk Road (Ratho Street to Port Glasgow Road) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2007 and shall come into force on midnight 18th May 2007 and shall cease to have effect at midnight on 19th May 2007.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b) or as authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(c).

Permission of Police Constable

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

Exemption for emergency vehicles

4. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes.
