The A84/A85 Trunk Road (Crianlarich) (30mph Speed Limit) Variation and
Crianlarich Primary School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007

2nd May 2007

Coming into force

16th May 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (c) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A84/A85 Trunk Road (Crianlarich) (30mph Speed Limit) Variation and Crianlarich Primary School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 16th May 2007.

Variation of the Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Perth and Kinross) Order 1975

2.—(1) The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Perth and Kinross) Order 1975(c) is varied in accordance with the following paragraphs.

(2) In article 5 at the beginning insert “Subject to article 5A below,”

(3) In article 5 for “the Schedule” substitute “Schedule 1”

(4) After article 5 insert—

“5A. —(1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 20mph when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22), Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by the Scotland Act 1998 (Consequential Modifications) Order 2001 (S.I. 2001/1400)) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by the Scotland Act 1998 (Transfer of Functions to the Scottish Ministers etc.) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/1750).

(2) A 20mph speed limit applies to the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order when a 20mph speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(a).”

(5) The Schedule is renumbered as Schedule 1.

(6) After the Schedule to the Order insert the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE 2

That length of the A84/A85 Stirling – Crianlarich Trunk Road at Crianlarich from a point 60 metres or thereby east of the extended east gable of Crianlarich Primary School westwards to a point 78 metres or thereby west of the extended east gable of Crianlarich Primary School, a distance of 138 metres or thereby.
