**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A82 Trunk Road (Scottish Open Golf Tournament, Loch Lomond) (Special Event)  
(Temporary Restriction of Speed ) Order 2007

<i>Made</i>	<i>19<sup>th</sup> June 2007</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>11<sup>th</sup> July 2007</i>

The Scottish Ministers make the following order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them to do so, being of the opinion that a temporary restriction of speed on the length of road specified in the schedule to this order is desirable because of consideration of public safety and convenience.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Scottish Open Golf Tournament, Loch Lomond) (Special Event) (Temporary Restriction of Speed) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2007 and shall cease to have effect at midnight on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2007.

**Temporary speed restriction**

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30mph daily between 0500 hours until 2200 hours.

SCHEDULE

That length of the A82 Dalnottar - Inverness Trunk Road from a point 200 metres or thereby south of the unclassified access road to Midross to a point 250 metres or thereby north of the A817 Glen Fruin Road Junction (Loch Lomond – Garelochhead Road), a distance of 2.75 kilometres or thereby.
