**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The M90 Motorway (Gairneybridge to Milnathort)  
(Temporary 50mph Speed Restriction) Order 2007

*Made*  
*Coming into force*

*22<sup>nd</sup> June 2007*  
*4<sup>th</sup> July 2007*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 88(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers enabling them to do so, being of the opinion that a temporary restriction of speed on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is desirable in the interest of safety.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the M90 Motorway (Gairneybridge to Milnathort) (Temporary 50mph Speed Restriction) Order 2007, shall come into force on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2007 and shall cease to have effect at midnight on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2007.

**Temporary speed restriction**

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 50 mph when a restriction is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

That length of the M90/A90 Inverkeithing – Fraserburgh Trunk Road from a point 2.5 kilometres or thereby south of junction 5, Gairneybridge, northwards to a point 2.5 kilometres or thereby north of junction 7, Milnathort, a distance of 12.66 kilometres or thereby.
