ROAD TRAFFIC

The A74 (M) Motorway (Junction 22) (Temporary Width Restriction of Traffic) Order 2007

Made 3rd August 2007
Coming into force 29th August 2007

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) and (4) and section 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited as hereinafter provided because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those lengths of road.

In accordance with Section 14(3) of that Act, they have regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A74 (M) Motorway (Junction 22) (Temporary Width Restriction of Traffic) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 29th August 2007 and shall cease to have effect at midnight on 28th February 2009.

Temporary restriction of use of vehicles

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule if the width exceeds 6 feet 6 inches when such restriction is identified as applying to part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

SCHEDULE

1. That length of road being the southbound carriageway on the A74(M) Glasgow - Carlisle Motorway from Marker Post 505/7 to the National Border, a distance of 1.0 kilometres or thereby
2. That length of road being the slip road from the A75 Gretna - Stranraer Trunk Road from a point 1.5 kilometres or thereby from its merge with the A74(M) to its merge with the A74(M), a distance of 1.5 kilometres or thereby.
