**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A725/A726 Trunk Road (Carmunnock Bypass, Queensway) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2007

<i>Made</i>	<i>3<sup>rd</sup> August 2007</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>20<sup>th</sup> August 2007</i>

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that pedestrians on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of an alternative route suitable for pedestrians which will be affected by this Order.

**Citation, Commencement and Cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the A725/A726 Trunk Road (Carmunnock Bypass, Queensway) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2007 and shall come into force on the 20<sup>th</sup> August 2007 and shall cease to have effect at midnight on the 30<sup>th</sup> November 2007.

**Prohibitions of Pedestrians**

2. Subject to Articles 3 and 4 of this Order, no person shall travel by foot on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order, when such prohibition is identified as applying to a part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b)

### **Permission or Direction of Police Constable**

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

### **Exemption for Emergency Vehicles**

4. No provision of this Order shall apply to persons carrying out the works or emergency personnel who require to use the road for fire brigade, ambulance, coastguard or police purposes.

## SCHEDULE 1

That length of the A725/A726 Shawhead – East Kilbride – Carmunnock Bypass Trunk Road being the A726 Queensway south footpath from Righead Road Roundabout westbound to Montreal Park, East Kilbride, a distance of 500 metres or thereby.
