**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A77 Trunk Road (Lendalfoot) (Special Event)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2007

*Made*

*9<sup>th</sup> August 2007*

*Coming into force*

*20<sup>th</sup> August 2007*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 16A(2) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be prohibited from waiting for the purpose of facilitating the holding of the Variag memorial event and enabling members of the public to watch that event.

In accordance with section 16A(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for such an event to be held otherwise than on that length of road.

In accordance with section 16A(8) of that Act, they have had regard to the safety and convenience of an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the A77 Trunk Road (Lendalfoot) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2007, shall come into force on 20th August 2007 and shall cease to have effect at midnight on 14th September 2007.

**Prohibition of use of vehicles**

2. Subject to Articles 3 and 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the length of road specified in the Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

### **Permission of police constable**

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

### **Exemption for emergency and works vehicles**

4. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes, or a vehicle while being used in connection with the unveiling of the memorial.
