The A828 Trunk Road (Duror) (40mph Speed Limit) and Duror Primary School
(Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007

22nd August 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (c) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A828 Trunk Road (Duror) (40mph Speed Limit) and Duror Primary School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 22nd August 2007.

40mph speed limit

2. Subject to article 3 below, no person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40mph.

Part-time 20mph speed limit

3. (1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 20mph when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by the Scotland Act 1998 (Transfer of Functions to the Scottish Ministers etc.) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/1750).

(2) A 20mph speed limit applies to the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order when a 20mph speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (a).”

SCHEDULE 1

That length of the A828 Connel – South Ballachulish Trunk Road at Duror from a point 300 metres or thereby southwest of the centre line of the U111 Cuil Bay Road northeastwards to a point 150 metres or thereby northeast of the extended centre line of the U123 Auchindarroch Road, a distance of 1.537 kilometres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 2

That length of the A828 Connel – South Ballachulish Trunk Road at Duror from a point 100 metres or thereby southwest of the centre line of the U111 Cuil Bay Road northeastwards to a point 100 metres or thereby northeast of the centre line of the U111 Cuil Bay Road, a distance of 200 metres or thereby.
