**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A83 Trunk Road (Minard) (40mph Speed Limit) Variation and Minard Primary School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007

<i>Made</i>	<i>16<sup>th</sup> August 2007</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>30<sup>th</sup> August 2007</i>

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (c) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A83 Trunk Road (Minard) (40mph Speed Limit) Variation and Minard Primary School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2007.

**Variation of the Trunk Roads (40mph Speed Limit) (Scotland) (No 8) Order 1963**

2. (1) The Trunk Roads (40mph Speed Limit) (Scotland) (No 8) Order 1963(c) is varied in accordance with the following paragraphs.

(2) In article 3 at the beginning insert "Subject to article 3A below,"

(3) In article 3 for the words "the Schedule" substitute "Schedule 1"

(4) After article 3 insert—

"3A. —(1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 20mph when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by the Scotland Act 1998 (Transfer of Functions to the Scottish Ministers etc.) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/1750).

(2) A 20mph speed limit applies to the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order when a 20mph speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (a).”

(5) The Schedule is renumbered as Schedule 1.

(6) After the Schedule to the Order insert the Schedule to this Order.

That length of the A83 Tarbet-Lochgilphead-Kennacraig Trunk Road at Minard from a point 8 metres or thereby southwest of the extended northeast gable of No 9 Lower Achagoyle to a point 12 metres or thereby southwest of the extended southwest gable of Jubilee Villa, a distance of 255 metres or thereby.

ORDER 200**

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS hereby give notice that they propose to make the above Order under section 84(1)(a) and (c) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will have the effect of imposing a part-time 20mph speed limit on the following length of road which currently has a 40mph speed limit:

That length of the A83 Tarbet-Lochgilphead-Kennacraig Trunk Road at Minard from a point 8 metres or thereby southwest of the extended northeast gable of No 9 Lower Achagoyle to a point 12 metres or thereby southwest of the extended southwest gable of Jubilee Villa, a distance of 255 metres or thereby.

The Trunk Roads (40mph Speed Limit) (Scotland) (No 8) Order 1963 will be varied by this Order to allow for the imposition of a part-time 20mph speed limit on this length of road, the part-time speed limit to apply when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the Order which, together with a plan showing the length of road involved, a copy of the existing Order to be varied and a statement of the Scottish Ministers' reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined free of charge during normal business hours from 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2006 until 31st August 2006 at Transport Scotland, Trunk Roads Network Management Directorate, Victoria Quay, Edinburgh EH6 6QQ; and Furnace Post Office, Furnace, Inverary, PA32 8XN.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send details of the grounds for objection in writing to Transport Scotland, Trunk Roads Network Management Directorate, Victoria Quay, Edinburgh, EH6 6QQ by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2006 .
