ROAD TRAFFIC

The M8/A8 Trunk Road (Chapleton Street to Anderson Street, Port Glasgow)
(Temporary 40mph Speed Limit) (No2) Order 2007

Made

25th October 2007

Coming into force

1st November 2007

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (4) and section 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited as hereinafter provided because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those lengths of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the M8/A8 Trunk Road (Chapleton Street to Anderson Street, Port Glasgow) (Temporary 40 mph Speed Limit) (No2) Order 2007 and shall come into force on, 1st November 2007 and shall cease to have effect at midnight on 31st January 2008.

Temporary speed restriction

2. No person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on that length of road specified in the Schedule at a speed exceeding 40 mph when identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(a).

SCHEDULE

That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh - Greenock Trunk Road from its junction with Chapleton Street to its junction with Anderson Street, Port Glasgow, a distance of 980 metres or thereby.

PRESS NOTICE

THE M8/A8 TRUNK ROAD (CHAPLETON STREET TO ANDERSON STREET, PORT
GLASGOW) (TEMPORARY 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (No2) ORDER 2007

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have made the above Order temporarily restricting the speed of vehicles to 40 mph on that length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh - Greenock Trunk Road from its junction with Chapleton Street to its junction with Anderson Street, Port Glasgow, a distance of 980 metres or thereby.

The Order, which is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road to allow a new section of trunk road to be opened, will be in operation from 1st November 2007 to midnight on 31st January 2008, but will only have effect in relation to such part or parts of that length of road as are indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.
