**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A90 Trunk Road (Longhaven Primary School) (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit)  
Order 2007

<i>Made</i>	29 <sup>th</sup> January 2007
<i>Coming into force</i>	12 <sup>th</sup> February 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and (c) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A90 Trunk Road (Longhaven Primary School) (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 12<sup>th</sup> February 2007
2. **Restriction of speed**
  2. (i) No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on the length of road specified in part one of the Schedule to this Order provided that the said prohibition shall apply only to the part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(c).
  - (ii) A 20mph speed limit applies to the length of road specified in part two of the Schedule to this Order when a 20mph speed limit is indicated by a traffic sign displaying flashing amber lights.
  - (iii) At all other times the National speed limit of 60 mph will apply.

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22), Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by the Scotland Act 1998 (Consequential Modifications) Order 2001 (S.I. 2001/1400)) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by the Scotland Act 1998 (Transfer of Functions to the Scottish Ministers etc.) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/1750).

### **Variation of previous Order**

3. The National Speed Limit applicable to this section of road is hereby varied to the effect that the National Speed Limit of 60mph shall cease to have effect over the length specified in the Schedule to The A90 Trunk Road (Longhaven Primary School) (Part-time 20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 during the times of operation of that Order.

That length of the M90/A90 Inverkeithing-Fraserburgh Trunk Road at Longhaven from a point 409 metres or thereby north of its junction with A975 northwards to a point 575 metres or thereby north of its junction with A975, a distance of 166 metres or thereby.

### The A90 Trunk Road (Longhaven Primary School) (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS hereby give notice that on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2007 they made the above Order under section 84(1)(a) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will have the effect of imposing a variable speed limit on the following length of road:

That length of the M90/A90 Inverkeithing-Fraserburgh Trunk Road at Longhaven from a point 409 metres or thereby north of its junction with A975 to a point 575 metres or thereby north of its junction with A975, a distance of 166 metres or thereby.

The National Speed Limit applicable to this section of road is hereby varied to the effect that the National Speed Limit of 60 mph shall cease to have effect over the length specified in the Schedule to The A90 Trunk Road (Longhaven Primary School) (Part-time 20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 during the times of operation of that Order.

The effect of the Order is as described in Notice 1501/226 in the Edinburgh Gazette number 3786 dated 27<sup>th</sup> October 2006 and in the Aberdeen Press and Journal dated 26<sup>th</sup> October 2006. The Order comes into force on 12<sup>th</sup> February 2007.
