The Diligence against Earnings (Variation) (Scotland) Revocation Regulations 2009

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 49(7)(a), 53(3) and 63(6) of the Debtors (Scotland) Act 1987(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Diligence against Earnings (Variation) (Scotland) Revocation Regulations 2009.

(2) They come into force on 28th March 2009.
