ROAD TRAFFIC

The M8 Motorway (White Cart Viaduct) (Temporary 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2009

Made

16th January 2009

Coming into force

1st February 2009

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(b) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited as hereinafter provided because of the likelihood of danger to the public or of serious damage to the road which is not attributable to works.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the M8 Motorway (White Cart Viaduct) (Temporary 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 and comes into force on 1st February 2009 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 31st July 2010.

Temporary speed restriction

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order

SCHEDULE

1. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh to Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound carriageway from the off slip to A741 Renfrew Road west to a point 400 metres west of the off slip to the A737/A738 St James Interchange – Kilwinning - Hawkhill Trunk Road, a distance of 4.2 kilometres or thereby.
2. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh to Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound carriageway from a point 3 metres or thereby west of Gantry S/G01840 to a point 100 metres or thereby west of Arkleston Over Bridge, a distance of 3 kilometres or thereby.
3. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh to Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound on slip from A741 Renfrew Road to the main carriageway, a distance of 50 metres or thereby.
4. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh to Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound off slip to Glasgow Airport (Junction 28), a distance of 50 metres or thereby.
5. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh to Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound on slip from St Andrews Drive, Glasgow Airport to the main carriageway, a distance of 34 metres or thereby.
